Profile Professional 2004 was designed with the professional in mind - Rehabilitation Specialists, Employment Counsellors, Psychologists, Guidance Counsellors and Health Care Professionals interested in matching people with occupations. *Profile's* database contains virtually all content found in the 2001 NOC and the complete NOC Career Handbook, combined with labour market information and salary data extracted from the latest Job Futures database.

Features

- Input, convert, and interpret GATB raw scores (see page 24)
- Ability to perform a Composite Transferrable Skills Analysis (C-TSA) based on a client's Work History
- View all 923 NOC Unit Groups or search through index of over 36,000 occupation/job titles
- On-line Help sections
- Include and/or exclude NOC characteristics when performing a search
- View the latest Job Futures Salary and Labour Market Information
- Estimate Interests and Aptitudes and search on these results
- Track your clients with the Client Database File
- In either C-TSA or Standard Modes of operation, control over how more than 50 selectable NOC descriptors can be modified, included or excluded during a comparison search of the NOC database.
- Select specific portions of the NOC Career Handbook database, categorized by specific Major or Minor Groups, Skill Levels, or Skill Types and restrict the comparison search to those titles.

Composite Transferrable Skills Analysis (C-TSA) Mode

This advanced feature enables you to build one NOC descriptor occupational profile that represents the combined NOC characteristics of all occupation titles in a client's work history. This composite profile can be easily modified and used to find matching occupation titles from the NOC database.

- Use *Profile's* NOC search engine to quickly find occupation titles and build a Work History containing an unlimited number of NOC occupations titles.
- Make changes to any of the NOC descriptors in the C-TSA profile. Then, search the complete NOC database, or user-selectable portions of the NOC to find matching occupation titles.
- Print a formatted C-TSA report that includes a Work History listing, Unadjusted C-TSA profile, Adjusted C-TSA profile, and occupation title listings.

Standard Mode

- Build a client profile incorporating any combination of NOC Career Handbook descriptors and let *Profile* find matching NOC Unit Group occupation titles filtered by: Aptitude Levels; Physical Activities; Environmental Conditions; Data, People, Things; Education/Training Indicators; Salary; Labour Market Information; CWPI Interest Code; or Main Characteristics Keywords.
- Print a variety of reports that include GATB test results, interpretation narratives, and occupation title listings.
