FACTS IN BRIEF

- Purpose:** Provides a comprehensive assessment of 14 areas of adaptive behaviour and 8 areas of problem behaviour
- Range:** Infancy–80+ years
- Time:** 45–60 minutes for Full Scale; 15–20 minutes for Short Form or Early Development Form
- Scores:** SS, PR, AE, RMI, instructional and development ranges, Support Score

The **SIB-R** is a comprehensive, norm-referenced assessment of adaptive and maladaptive behaviours.

Features

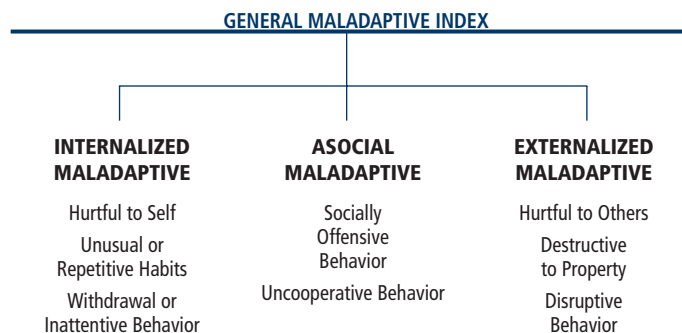
- Simplified administration: test items now appear in each response booklet (Early Development, Short Form, or Full Scale) as well as in the Interview Book, increasing examiner options and convenience.
- Expanded age range: the increased range allows for better assessment of the infant/toddler and geriatric populations.
- Expanded item content: the 33 new items give a broader measure of the adaptive behaviour skills required in everyday living.
- Simplified scoring: age-equivalent scoring tables are included in the response booklets for each subscale, allowing examiners to get immediate developmental information.
- Increased interpretive options: the Support Score predicts the level of support a person will require based on the impact of maladaptive behaviours on adaptive functioning. Functional limitations in adaptive behaviour can be identified.
- Improved monitoring capability: the new Individual Plan Recommendation (IPR) form, included with each response booklet, is used to plan and track a person's support and service needs and goals.



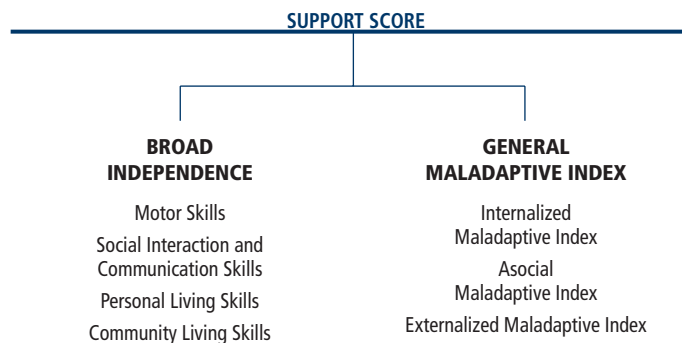
Administration

The *SIB-R* can be administered using either a structured interview procedure or a checklist procedure. The checklist-administration procedure is often preferred when a fact-to-face interview is not necessary or practical. These options give examiners maximum flexibility when using the *SIB-R*.

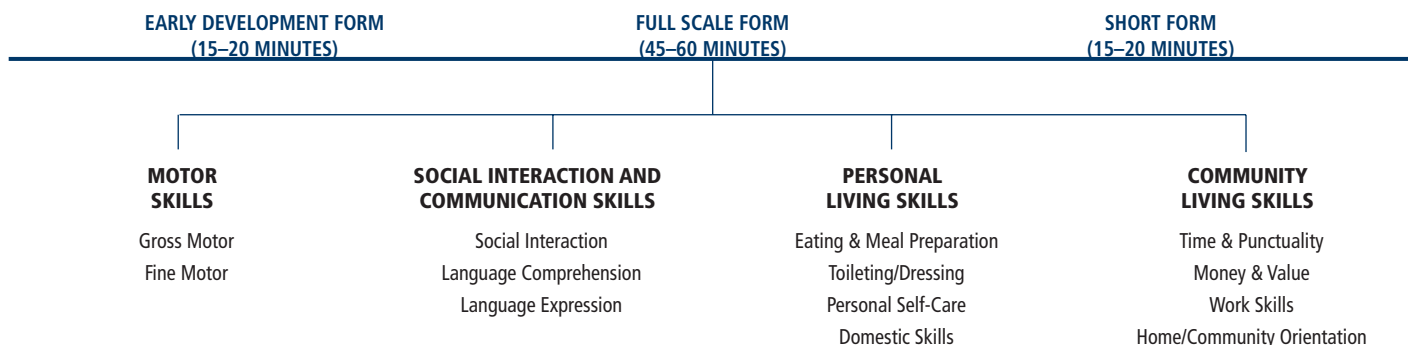
3 Problem Behavior Clusters

Use the entire system and get the full benefit of its integrated design, or choose the element or elements that meet your needs. Each element can be used independently or in conjunction with the other elements.

CALS and ALSC look at approximately 800 specific behaviours organized into skill modules in four broad domains: Personal Living Skills, Home Living Skills, Community Living Skills, and Employment Skills.

Each behaviour in CALS has a corresponding instructional unit in ALSC. Behaviours cover the continuum of development from infancy to adulthood.
